Welcome to WIT WAR, the premier quiz competition of Sci-Fi Fare 2.0! Prepare to battle minds, think fast, and answer smart. Below is the comprehensive rulebook and guideline for all participating teams.

1. Team Formation & Eligibility

- Team Size: Each team must have 3 members.
- Exclusivity: Participants are strictly permitted to join only **one team**. Make ensure that each member of the team belongs to **higher secondary** students.
- Institutional Affiliation: It is highly recommended that all members of a team belong to the same institution but not mandatory.

2. Syllabus

Questions will be designed to test your knowledge and analytical skills in the following subjects:

- Physics
- Chemistry
- ICT (Information & Communication Technology)
- Mathematics

3. Competition Structure

The competition will be divided into three distinct phases:

Round 1: Preliminary

- All registered teams will participate simultaneously.
- Conducted entirely online via the **Slido** platform.
- The top **(Four) 4** scoring teams will qualify for the Semifinal.
- Five objective type questions will be set up from each subjects mentioned.

Subject Overview

- **Format:** Multiple Choice (**MCQ**) based question.
- **Quantity:** 5 (**Five**) questions per subject. Each question must be answered within **1 minute**.
- **Standard:** Basic and Preliminary Standard.
- **Difficulty Level:** 01

Round 2: Semifinal

- The 4 (**Four**) qualifying teams will compete head-to-head.
- The top 2 (**Two**) teams will secure their spot in the Final.

Semi-Final Overview

- **Format:** Multiple Choice (MCQ) based question.
- **Quantity:** 5 (Five) questions from (Physics, Chemistry, Higher Mathematics). Each question must be answered within **45 Seconds**.
- **Standard:** Moderated.
- **Difficulty Level:** 02

Round 3: Final Battle

- The ultimate showdown between the top 2 (Two) teams.
- The highest scorer of this round will be crowned the Champion of Wit War.

Final Overview

- **Format:** Multiple Choice (MCQ) based question.
- **Quantity:** 5 (Five) questions from (Physics, Higher Mathematics). Each question must be answered within **30 Seconds**.
- **Standard:** Advanced.
- **Difficulty Level:** 03

4. Technical Requirements (Platform & Device Rules)

This is an **online-based** interactive competition. To ensure a smooth experience, teams must adhere to the following technical requirements:

- **Platform:** The quiz will be hosted exclusively on the **Slido Website**.
- **Required Devices:** Each team must have access to at least one Android smartphone.
- **Connectivity:** A strong and stable internet connection is mandatory to prevent submission delays.
- **Access:** The specific Slido event **code/link** will be provided to the teams shortly before the quiz begins.

5. Gameplay Mechanics (Slido System)

- **Time Limits:** Each question will feature a strict, fixed countdown timer.
- **Submissions:** Answers must be locked in before the timer runs out. Late submissions will not be counted by the system.
- **Speed Bonus:** The Slido platform rewards speed. Faster correct answers may yield a higher score or a competitive advantage on the leaderboard.

6. Tie-Breaker Protocol

In the event of a tie between teams for a qualifying spot or the championship, the following tie-breaker methods will be applied:

- **Fastest Response:** The team with the fastest average response time for correct answers (calculated by Slido) will be favored.

- **Sudden Death:** If a tie persists, additional tie-breaker questions will be presented until a winner emerges.
- **Time Limit:** 20 seconds for breaking tie.

7. Code of Conduct & General Rules

- **Authority:** All teams must strictly follow the instructions provided by the authority.
- **Integrity:** Strict adherence to academic integrity is required. The use of unauthorized materials, external assistance, or any form of academic misconduct is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate disciplinary action. Any team caught violating this will face immediate disqualification.
- **Punctuality:** All teams must be present and logged in on time with the **registered team name**.
